**Cronomer Valley Fire District No1.  
Resolution #24-03**

At the Special Meeting of the Cronomer Valley Fire District Board of Fire Commissioners held on September 27, 2024, the below resolution was adopted;

“The Cronomer Valley Fire District provides a safe working environment to employees as required by New York State Law. We will continue to train our employees and monitor situations that lead to workplace violence and an uncomfortable workplace atmosphere that leads to degradation of service.

Whereas the Cronomer Valley Fire District leases the property at 296 North Plank Road and owns adjoining properties for conducting business, training of employees, emergency response and readiness and housing its equipment. The Fire District holds the right to ban employees and third-party individuals that are determined to be a threat by workplace violence and intimidation from said premises.

Be it resolved that Michael B. Leghorn has been identified as an individual that has intimidated employees of the Cronomer Valley Fire District and continues to approach employees on and off premises making them uncomfortable and intimidated.

Michael B. Leghorn is hereby banned from the properties owned and leased by the Cronomer Valley Fire District to prevent further harassment. “
